

## SWARM SEASON

### THOSE TERRIBLE TERMITES

WHEN DO THEY SWARM? Spring is breeding season for most species of termites. Florida's temperate climate provides the perfect environment and signs of structural damage to a home may go undetected for a long time. Termites swarm in large numbers over a wide area to find a mate from another colony to start up a new colony. Moisture and a nearby timber food supply can provide ideal conditions for termite infestations. To help protect your home or property from termites:

- Get an inspection to identify conditions that may be conducive to a termite infestation.
- Trim shrubs and tree limbs away from the house
- Direct downspouts away from the foundation
- Turn out lights at night that would attract termites
- Keep all sources of wood away from the foundation of the house, including wood chips as mulch near the house. Call us if you have any concerns about termites.

## SPRING CLEANING

Spring and summer are usually the most active seasons for pests such as ticks, mosquitoes and ants. Here are some tips to help prevent them from getting inside your house:

- Seal cracks and small entry points along your home's foundation
- Trim tree branches and shrubs to keep them away from your house

- Keep mulch and leaves away from the house
- Clean out your gutters
- Add screens to all windows and doors
- Get rid of standing water (mosquitoes are attracted to water)

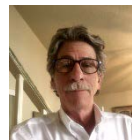
